

Application Supplement 1 – Degree & Knowledge

In accordance with section 41(2) of the Bylaws of the BC College of Social Workers, to be eligible to apply for registration without a social work degree, you must:

1. Have a degree in a related field from an accredited academic program.

The following Bachelor degrees are considered related:

- Bachelor of Arts in Child and Youth Care
- Bachelor of Arts in Psychology
- Bachelor of Arts in Sociology

The following Master degrees are considered related:

- Master of Arts in Counselling Psychology
- Master of Education in Counselling Psychology
- Master of Divinity in Theology

2. Demonstrate substantive formal education in each of the following subject areas:

- Social welfare
- Social policy
- Social Work ethics
- Social Work practice
- Social Work theory
- Human Behaviour and Development
- Research methods

Note that each applicant must demonstrate substantial equivalence to a social work degree. Substantial equivalence is not met if an applicant has taken one course or completed introductory (pre-requisite) courses in the above topic areas. Applications are considered in their totality. It is expected that applicants with related degrees would present with substantive upper level credits.

1. Complete page 2 and 3 of this form.
2. Arrange to have official transcripts sent directly to the BCCSW from the educational institution of your related degree and for each course listed on page 2 and 3.
3. Provide a course description for each course listed on page 2 and 3.
4. Make a copy of your material as the submission to the College will not be returned.
